These four beautiful beefs, as seen in the above photo on Janzen Family Farms brome, have been grazing on our pastures for just over two years. That means a new supply of our marbled, tender JFF grass-fed beef will be available for you soon! To that end, we have four processing slots reserved at Peabody Sausage House—two in November and two in December.

Amid the pandemic, demand has been high, so please order soon to secure your portion. Locker purchases (in which you pick up your order directly from the butcher) are only available for halves and wholes. Orders are reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. (Please note that for now, we are maintaining the same prices, but in order to keep sustainable farming financially sustainable for the farmers, we are expecting to increase prices next year.)

To order, just fill out an [order form](#) and return it with a deposit of half the estimated final amount. Feel free to pay by check or credit card.
